Please make payments before the end of January to allow us to process the registration forms before sending them to the British Council. Please be aware that there is a significant charge for any late entries. Payment slips should be presented to the Accountant in School.

Year 11 students are in the final week of their mock examinations and will resume on normal timetable next Monday. There will be a Parents' Day for all Year 11 parents to discuss students' performance in the light of the mock examination results. This will take place on Saturday 6th February between 8.30am and 12.00noon. Please make a note in your diaries.
